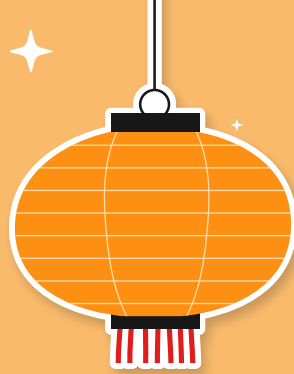
- If a member misses more than 2 meetings, the member is now on probation

Dear my fellow Civil Rights Activists,

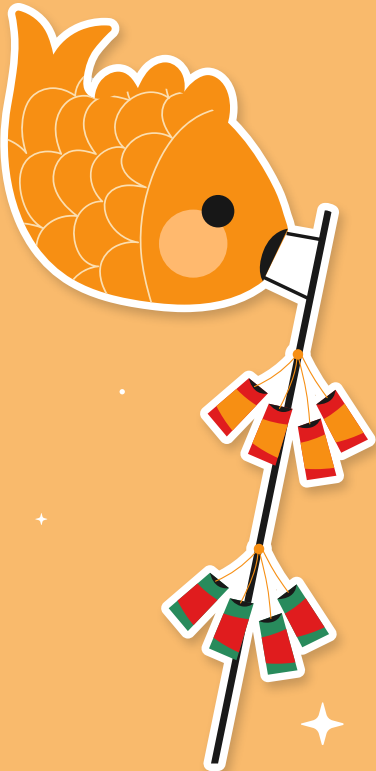

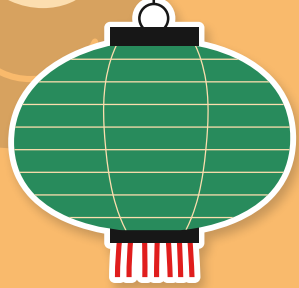

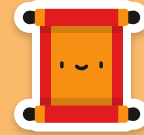

WHAT ARE THEY?

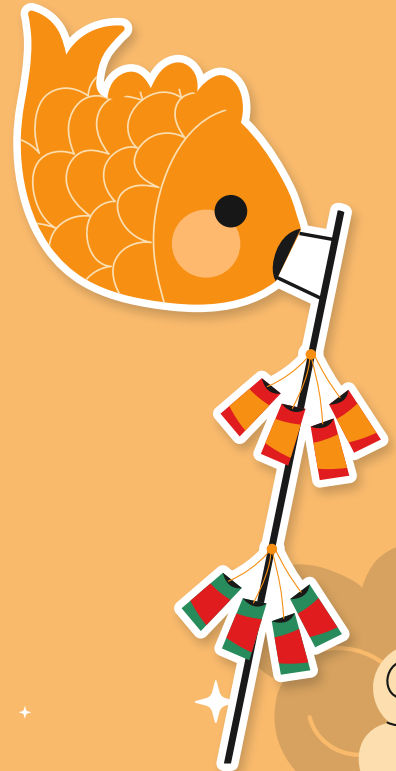
Short Monthly Lectures hosted by members themselves based on any history topic of their choosing

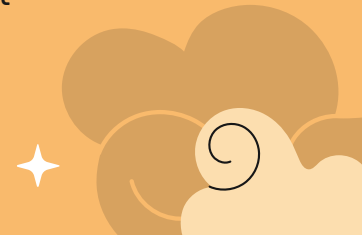
- Social Studies UIL Team will be hosted through **Mr. Krenek**

Can be written about any historical topic
And can be made short (1,500 - 2,500) OR long (4,000 - 6,000). Must include Turabian endnotes and bibliography

Due: By end-of-year
